## Dear Parents,

I hope this letter finds you well. Thank you for taking the time to read through this important letter. Although it seems early to be thinking about summer, the more time and information you have, the more outstanding the experience will be for our students.

To our 8<sup>th</sup> grade friends, as you begin to schedule your high school classes, your involvement in the Band program here at the high school begins as well. I hope the time that you spent with high school band members gave you an idea of what the high school band experience is like. We are all very excited to have you join us!

There will be a Marching Band Orientation Meeting via Google Meet on Wednesday, the 22nd of February at 7:00pm. A great deal of information and discussion will be available during this meeting, parents and students make every effort to attend, especially if you are still deciding about high school band for your student. Returning members & parents of the FHS Band Program are encouraged to attend this meeting as well.

The Marching Band is comprised of freshmen members of the Band Program, and committed upperclassmen. It is a great deal of fun as well as a bonding opportunity for all students. Incoming freshmen will meet the older kids and make new friends before the first day of school. A great deal of hard work and effort go into producing a well rehearsed performing ensemble, but if you have seen our past performances, you can tell that it is its own reward.

## Fenton High School Marching Band Season 2023 Initial Details:

• Pre Camp is REQUIRED for all members and begins on Monday July 24 at 9 am - 12 am at FHS and runs until Wednesday, July 26th. Monday, only new members, drum majors and sectional leaders are required to attend. Tuesday and Wednesday the full band is required to attend. This will help our new members get acclimated to this new and fun experience and help our returning members get back in the swing of things. This is also where students will receive school instruments, music, other marching band accessories.

## **BAND CAMP**

Adrian College - 110 S Madison St, Adrian, MI 49221

- Band Camp begins on Sunday, July 30, and ends Saturday, August 5. (Sunday Afternoon Saturday Noon). Camp will be held at Adrian College.
- Please plan to arrive at the FHS AUX GYM <u>SUNDAY AFTERNOON July 30, at 4:00</u> PM to drop off your students. We will be taking Fenton School Buses to camp. Students are to be picked-up by their parents following the 10:00 AM Saturday morning performance at Adrian College.
- All students' medications must be checked in and given to a chaperone upon arrival at FHS. It must
  be labeled and in its original prescription bottle. This includes all medication. BASIC OVER THE
  COUNTER MEDICATIONS (ibuprofen, etc.), WILL BE STOCKED AT CAMP AND ADMINISTERED
  ACCORDING TO PARENTAL PERMISSIONS GIVEN ON THE CAMP FORM. Please contact me or Joy
  Scott (band camp coordinator) with any questions regarding distribution of medication.
- All students and staff will be staying AT CAMP in the college dorms. Do Not Bring Unnecessary
   Valuables to camp. Students will need very little money at camp. They may want to bring cash for the
   vending machines or for snacks. Additional details on what to bring to camp will be provided.
- Proper apparel must be brought and worn at camp. Gym shoes or cross-trainers are mandatory, no sandals, boots, flip-flops, heels on the field. Socks must be worn with your shoes, to prevent blisters. Shorts are a great idea, light pants are even better (sunburn), as well as white T-shirts, which will keep you cooler than a tank top or cutoff. A cap or hat is great to keep the sun off your face and chops.

Other good items include a Water Bottle, ChapStick, Sunscreen, Sunglasses, and Swimsuit. Ask an upperclassman at the meeting!

- If a band member becomes ill or injured during camp, his or her parents will be asked to take them home. While we will treat minor aches and pains (as well as medical emergencies), it is the responsibility of the parent to bring their child home if their condition becomes acute.
- <u>Instrument Repair</u>: PLEASE make sure that your students' instrument is in working condition at the end of the school year. There will NOT be an on-site instrument repair at camp. If your student's instrument is in need of repair during the week of camp, a parent will need to drive to Adrian College and get it repaired or the student will need to use it to the best of his/her ability for the remainder of the week. Check with Mr. Conaton at the end of the school year to make sure your instrument is in its best condition or to make arrangements for repair.
- The end of camp Performance will be on Saturday morning August 5th (10am). All friends and family are encouraged to attend. This will also be the point at which the students need to be picked up, so come on out and enjoy their first show! Reminder: Students will need a pair of clean, Solid Black Shorts to wear in the final performance. They will be given a 2022 Band T-shirt for the show (included in the camp costs). Shoes worn at camp ARE acceptable for this performance only.
- Consider when you will be able to help chaperone at camp (Parents of all marching band students are highly encouraged to commit to one shift of chaperone duties during the week of camp). We can always use more adult eyes and ears! This is also a great time to let your kids know that you support them and the band and to see how hard they work. We will have sign-up dates and times available online starting in May. Please contact Joy Scott (Band Camp Coordinator) at 810-449-2944 or bandcamp.fentonband@gmail.com with questions.
- The total cost for the Marching Band Season is \$450 (not including Marching Shoes) for all members. This fee covers almost all expenses for the entire school year, including all lodgings at camp, meals, activities, instructors, lanyards, flip folders, a camp T-shirt, all bus Transportation, and uniform cleaning/maintenance fees. The total payment can be made through EFunds and/or cash or check. Checks should be made out to FENTON BAND BOOSTERS and should be delivered to the black booster box in the band room by June 2nd.

Reminder - The FHS Marching Band rehearses **ZERO HOUR**, **6:30am - 7:20am** at FHS. Rehearsals are Monday – Friday through October, and are mandatory, as marching band is an academic class for which the students receive credit. There will also be 2-3 practices in August. These rehearsal times/dates will be set in June and are crucial to our preparedness for the first football game.

I am looking forward to this year with great excitement and enthusiasm and hope you all are too. Please make every effort to attend the orientation meeting on February 22nd, as a great deal of information and specifics will be available. As always, feel free to contact me if you have concerns.
